The center is specifically designed to advance creative solutions to federal challenges through interactive sessions that keep users, civil servants and technology at the center of practical innovation. The state-of-the-art facility acts as the backbone for workshop processes and outcomes.

The Innovation Center is equipped with a variety of conference spaces and tools to provide an outlet for demonstrations, presentations, training and collaboration. Overall, the Innovation Center facilitates workshops that help solve some of the largest and continually evolving challenges faced by the U.S. federal government and other financial service clients in the Washington D.C. area.

Clients and partners use immersive video walls, touch tables and interactive kiosks to explore today's technology in new ways and support innovation in action. A conference center and meeting spaces throughout the facility can be configured to host teams of any size. CGI's workshop facilitators, technical subject matter experts and professionals support the innovation developed at the center with an intimate understanding of the federal market.

Arlington spotlight

Ballston, an urban neighborhood in Arlington, Virginia, is home to a fully interactive space for CGI members to facilitate client engagement.

Just outside of the United States capital, the CGI Federal Innovation Center consists of approximately 57,000 square feet of the Marymount University Ballston Center building and holds a business partnership with the Marymount School of Business.

The Innovation Center expanded CGI's global network of Innovation Centers with a DC-area facility designed to specialize on supporting the unique challenges faced by the federal government and helping agencies explore creative approaches to mission success.

Description of spaces and assets

The Studio

The CGI Federal Innovation Center's largest and most flexible collaboration space is the **Studio** with a maximum capacity of 110 people and five customizable furniture configuration options. The Studio has immersive video walls and is outfitted with full A/V capabilities, including microphone options, a camera for video conferencing, and four additional multi-input, multi-purpose display screens.

The Franklin Room and the Edison Room

The Innovation Center has two large breakout conference rooms: the **Franklin Room** and the **Edison Room**. Each room holds approximately 15 people with overflow window bench seating. The rooms are furnished with whiteboard walls, large monitors and A/V capabilities for hosting virtual meetings and presentations.

Other spaces

For small conference calls, the **Mark Twain Room** is available. There is VR capability for members to hold meetings in the "metaverse."

The **reception area** is intended to provide additional networking space with relaxed conversational areas and an interactive touch table.

Beyond the Innovation Conference Center, CGI has **three floors of workspace and meeting rooms** with whiteboard walls, display screens and conferencing lines for reservation.

Additionally, CGI's partnership with Marymount University's School of Business allows members access to their **auditorium theater** for gatherings up to 200 people.
