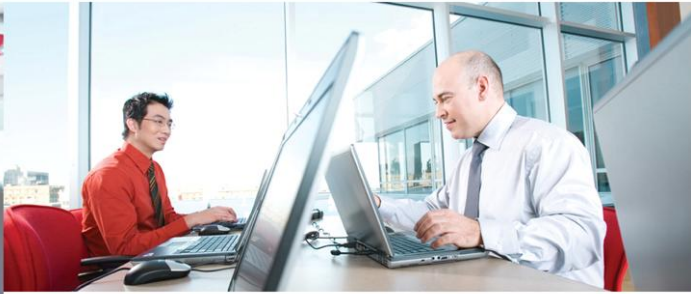

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION AND FEATURES

CGI's HITS system (Habitational Insurance Tracking System) provides insurers with online access to the most comprehensive source of personal property claims information available today.

Underwriters rely on HITS to identify bad risks before they become a part of their book of business. HITS is also beneficial to claims personnel because it provides detailed claims history, which allows patterns of suspicious claims to be identified early in the claims adjustment process and appropriate action to be taken.

HITS is available to any insurer that provides historical claims data, along with its brokers and agents. To ensure access to the most current information, participating companies must submit regular updates after their initial contribution of up to five years of claims data. Insurers can access HITS quickly and easily through the Internet or by leveraging Web services, API, host-to-host or batch technology, depending on their business requirements.

HITS not only delivers comprehensive habitational claims information but also other valuable tools to improve insurers' underwriting success. These tools include HITS Valuation, which provides instant access to replacement cost and construction information, and HITSPPlus, a property loss risk assessment tool.
