

Women in STEM statistics

1,000,000+

As of 2019, there are now just over 1,000,000 women in the core STEM workforce in the UK



This represents an increase of over 350,000 in the last 10 years

24%



This means that women now make up 24% of the core-STEM workforce 30%



Evidence suggests that 30% is the 'critical mass' level at which a minority group becomes able to influence real change

WE CAN EXPECT THE UK FEMALE STEM WORKFORCE TO REACH JUST OVER 29% IN 2030, SO WE NEED A FURTHER PUSH TO BREAK THROUGH 30%*
