



Mobile reporting



Cross-media workflows

Photos, videos, PDFs and more — **all types of files can be combined in a box**, and they stay together. They are transferred and saved in the production system as combined objects.

Extensive metadata such as keywords, IPR information and comments can be added and transferred for each media file as well as for the box.

Cloud-Enabled

The backend system, which manages the transfers from the smartphone to the content management system and controls the uploads, is **designed to be operated either on the premises or in the cloud** at the client's discretion. Encrypted communication paths and passwords ensure **security and privacy**.
