How to play “STEM Who Am I?” game in person

- Print out or write down the jobs below and cut them out so that they are individual words. Then put all the individual pieces of paper into a container.
- Player 1 picks a job out of the container and reads it (help may be necessary for younger children). Do not tell anyone else what job has been chosen.
- Other players should take turns ask probing questions about what the job is to try to guess what it is such as:
 - Do you work outside?
 - Do you help people?
 - Do you work on a computer?
 - Do you work at a hospital?
 - Do you make something as part of your job?
- Repeat the cycle so that everyone has a few turns.

How to play “STEM Who Am I?” game virtually

- Teacher shows all the jobs on the screen and describes them.
- Player 1 thinks of a job of the ones presented.
- Other players should take turns ask probing questions about what the job is to try to guess what it is such as:
 - Do you work outside?
 - Do you help people?
 - Do you work on a computer?
 - Do you work at a hospital?
 - Do you make something as part of your job?
- Once a job has been picked, it should not be selected again.
- Repeat the cycle so that everyone has a few turns.
