High Level Overview

Student preparation in advance of lesson:

- Complete the Nature Scavenger Hunt
- Have thought about the reflection questions at the end of the Scavenger Hunt

Student Learning Objectives

- Identify specific objects in a natural setting
- Connect pictures and words to items in the natural environment
- Increase interest in and appreciation for the natural environment

Nature Scavenger Hunt – Talk It Out

60 minutes

Welcome and introduction

5 min

Have students talk about their experience on the nature scavenger hunt

50 min

Use the following as discussion questions – spend about 10 minutes per question

- Where did you do your scavenger hunt?
 - What was your favorite thing about the scavenger hunt?
 - What was the hardest item to find?
 - What did you learn on your walk?
 - How did the walk make you feel?
