Audit remediation for the federal government



CFO point of view

As leaders invested in transparency, accountability and process improvement to enhance operations, CFOs have an elevated view on the major factors influencing an agency's audit findings. In many cases, however, they may lack the internal resources to address and resolve all deficiencies in question in a timely manner. Through risk-based prioritization, audit remediation pivots from a compliance exercise to strategic financial management and reporting transformation.

Actions for strategic audit remediation

- 1. Assemble a governance body with entity knowledge, relevant experience and sufficient coverage over all material components, business cycles and information systems across the agency
- 2. Compile and consider all relevant findings from external and internal sources
- Group findings by common characteristics (e.g. business cycle, information system) and assess their level of financial reporting risk and potential impact to the agency
- 4. Prioritize remediation efforts to achieve the greatest return on investment toward reliable and efficient financial reporting
- 5. Develop a comprehensive remediation plan for high-risk / high-impact business cycles and related systems
