



The importance of being a Product Owner

Capabilities

Obvious perhaps, but all too often overlooked. A PO ensures that a delivered product will provide value. A mix of knowledge, reflection, consultation and analysis should be backed by a talent for research, review and evaluation.

Capacity

Many POs already have another job, restricting the time they have to define work with creativity and innovation, evaluate delivery effectively and forecast accurately. A true product vision needs to be maintained by timely, evidenced interventions, often made at pace.

Authority

Whether selecting or removing tasks, the PO's decisions need to carry the respect of the team. An Agile team needs a single authority, who can take a holistic view across stakeholder and business demands, and keep the workflow goal-focused.

When selecting a PO, consider it as a role, not a secondary responsibility, and recruit accordingly. The most successful POs have experience across several relevant disciplines to draw on, so check for the following experience:



Product manager

Understands the product, its customer needs and place in the market. Knows how to shape user stories and communicate clear product requirements for the development team.



Subject Matter Expert

Knows the sector inside out and is able to bring relevant industry and business insights to provide a referential frame and inform development decisions.



Business Analyst

Experienced in business transformation, capturing requirements from internal stakeholders and analysing impacts of change on the business.
