Our approach: achieving a controlled migration

We implemented a structured, three-step approach to ensure the seamless migration of Sodexo UK's IT infrastructure and applications to Microsoft Azure.

By working closely with Sodexo's IT, operations, and global teams, we assessed the workloads under consideration, analysed dependencies, and developed a tailored migration plan. Our approach prioritised risk mitigation, minimising disruption, and ensuring zero data loss, whilst balancing cost and performance.

1 Discover

We began by configuring Azure Migrate tooling in Sodexo's environment. This provided detailed analysis of the on-premises infrastructure, applications, and interdependencies, creating a clear baseline for migration planning.

2 Assess

Using insights from the discovery phase, we worked with Sodexo's IT teams to evaluate their workloads and identify suitable candidates for migration. This phase focused on:

- Tailoring the migration plan to meet Sodexo's specific requirements and constraints.
- Conducting testing and performance analysis to ensure workloads were right-sized and fully operational in Azure.
- Implementing cost optimisation strategies to maximise value and minimise expenditure.

3 Migrate

First, we validated the migration approach with a proof of concept, followed by a full migration schedule. Over several months, we managed controlled, incremental migrations to avoid data loss or unplanned outages. The success of the migration was achieved through our:

- Azure cloud engineering migration activities and thorough testing.
- Cost optimisation considerations for migrated workloads.
- Performance analysis and rightsizing to ensure efficiency.
- Technical leadership and consulting for Sodexo's Azure, application, security, and networking teams.
- Detailed technical planning and coordination to minimise disruption to Sodexo's operations.
- Automated workload configurations to streamline processes.
- Collaboration with Sodexo's UK, global, and third-party networking teams.
