



Terms and Conditions for CGI Festive TechConnect Prize Draw

December 2025

1. Introduction

These terms and conditions apply to the CGI Festive TechConnect Prize Draw (**Prize Draw**) run and promoted by CGI IT UK Limited whose registered office is at 20 Fenchurch Street, 14th Floor, London EC3M 3BY (**CGI**). CGI's address for correspondence is set out in section 14 below.

The Prize Draw is managed by EC1 (Basingstoke) Limited whose registered office is at Unit 4, Bessemer Road, Basingstoke, Hampshire, England, RG21 3NB, trading as everything creative (**everything creative**) on behalf of CGI.

By entering the Prize Draw, entrants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

2. Eligibility

The Prize Draw is open to residents of the United Kingdom who are aged 18 years and over, subject to the exceptions below:

- Employees and workers of, and other individuals who provide services to, the following organisations may not participate in the Prize Draws (**Staff**):
 - i) CGI and its associated companies;
 - ii) everything creative; and
 - iii) any organisation directly involved in or associated with the operation, administration and promotion of the Prize Draws.

- Members of the immediate families of Staff may not participate in the Prize Draw.

CGI reserves the right to require proof of age and residency in the United Kingdom.

3. Prize Draw Period

There will be one Prize Draw, with entries for the Prize Draw to be submitted between 09:00 hours GMT on 19th December 2025 until 23:59 hours GMT on 23rd December 2025 (**the Prize Draw Period**). To be valid and accepted entries must be received (via the link set out in section 4. below) within the Prize Draw Period. Entries received outside the Prize Draw Period will not be accepted.

4. Entry Requirements

There are two stages to the Prize Draw. To enter the Prize Draw, participants must visit www.CGI-Festive-TechConnect.co.uk and read and follow the instructions on www.CGI-Festive-TechConnect.co.uk. There will be five “clouds” on the page which participants should click to access information behind each “cloud”. The participant must read the information behind each of the five “clouds” and then proceed to answer one question relating to the information behind all of the “clouds”. A correct answer to the question will enable the participant

to enter a prize draw by completing and submitting a separate form (**entry form**) to provide their full name and email address. The entry form will be available via a pop-up box on the same web page. The completed and properly submitted entry form will then be entered into a randomly selected draw to win a prize. The winner will be the first completed entry form which is randomly drawn from all the entries correctly submitted in the Prize Draw. The prize will be as described in section 5. below (or similar).

Only one entry per person for the Prize Draw is permitted. More than one entry submitted by the same person will be void.

Entries must be received before 24:00 hours (midnight) GMT on 23rd December 2025.

No purchase or payment is required to enter the Prize Draw or to receive prizes.

5. Prizes

There will be one prize awarded. The prize will be the same as or similar to that listed below with a value up to and not exceeding a typical retail price of £1,600.00 (one thousand and six hundred pounds sterling) including VAT. CGI reserves the right to substitute a prize with an item of a similar description and value. If the winner is based in Northern Ireland the prize may be of a different specification, or a prize of equivalent value may be substituted, to comply with the laws of Northern Ireland. Any descriptions, images, illustrations or depictions of prizes are for illustrative purposes only and may not show or describe the exact prize. The prize is non-transferable, and no cash or other alternative prize is offered.

6. Winner Selection and Notification

At 12:00 hours (noon) GMT on 24th December 2025 a winner will be selected from the entries submitted in the Prize Draw during the Prize Draw Period using a computer process that generates random results. Any decision by CGI or selection of the winner using the computer random generated result is final. The winner will be notified by e-mail sent to the email address given in the entry form (**Winner Notification**) as soon as practicable after the Prize Draw has taken place and in any event by no later than 5 January 2026. Winners will be asked to acknowledge receipt of the email and provide a postal address in the UK for delivery of the prize (**Acknowledgment**). Addresses outside the UK are not accepted. If it is not possible to contact a winner using the contact details in the winner's entry form or if no acknowledgement is received after a period of 2 (two) weeks after the first attempt at contact, the prize will be forfeited.

7. Delivery of Prizes

The prize will be sent to the winner to the address provided by the winner in the Acknowledgment of the Winner Notification by pre-paid post. Prizes will only be sent to addresses in the UK. Neither CGI nor everything creative nor any of their respective associated entities shall be responsible for any damage or loss during transit and there is no obligation on CGI or everything creative to provide a replacement or financial recompense in the event of damage or loss. Prizes will be dispatched by pre-paid post or courier before or on 31 January 2026.

8. Data Protection

Personal data provided during the Prize Draw process will be used in accordance with CGI's Privacy Policy, which can be found at [Data Privacy Policy | CGI.com](#). Data provided by participants will only be used to process entries, for the administration and management of this Prize Draw and as required by law or regulation.

CGI reserves the right to cancel, suspend or amend the Prize Draw, the prizes and these terms and conditions at any time. Any cancellation, suspension or amendment will be notified via CGI's website www.cgi.com/uk

12. Disqualification
