Addressing document management challenges

Signing and archiving documents are integral document management processes in organizations across industries. These tasks, which include printing, scanning and emailing documents, are time-consuming and pose several challenges, including the following:

Document retrieval:

Studies show that approximately 20% of an employee's work time involves locating documents, and as much as 7.5% of physical documents in the office are lost for good.

Storage capacity:

Archiving physical documents requires significant storage space.

Location dependency:

When an organization sends a contract by mail and the contracting parties are not physically present in the same place, signing delays result.

Scanning time:

Scanning hand-signed documents into a digital format is time-intensive. Scanning a single page, alone, takes several minutes.

Data loss:

Documents stored on local workstations and network drives risk possible data loss and may not be compliant with document archiving regulations and legislation.

Security:

Physical documents involve significant information security risks because they can easily end up in the wrong hands

when people circulate or store them. Sensitive material sent by e-mail also involves security risks because it travels through systems and services that unauthorized people can access.

Compliance:

In many cases, staff must comply with legislative and regulatory document management requirements, as well as their own organization's requirements.




